Sage Memorial run takes place Saturday

NEWPORT – Runners will set off from the Newport City Park on the first ever Sage Memorial 5K White Rose Run Saturday, July 17, beginning at 8 a.m.

The race benefits the Northwest Infant Survival and SIDS Alliance (NISSA). It's organized by Cindy Campbell and held in honor of her nephew, Sage Lawrence Elderedge, who died of SIDS two years ago. Campbell hopes to make the memorial run an annual event.

For those who haven't registered yet, the fee is \$25.

Along with the 5-kilometer run/walk, there will be two special races for kids. Sage's Dash is for kids 5 and younger, and another division is for 6- to 12-year-olds. The kids' run starts at 7:35 a.m.

Free race photos will be available, and there will be refreshments and raffle prizes after the race. The 5K will be chip-timed. An awards ceremony begins at 9:30 a.m. Awards will be given in all age categories and to the overall male and female.
